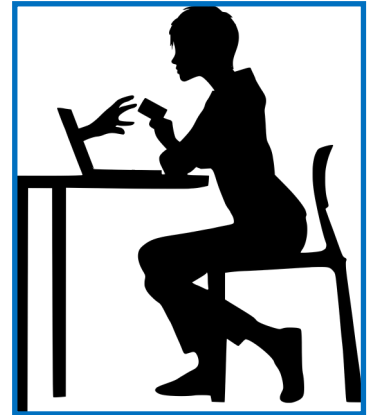


SCAM ALERT

What if you received the email below, stating your credit card was being charged \$199 for something you did not order? For ANY email you receive that makes your heart (or mind) race, Generations on Line recommends taking a breath and using a little TLC to protect yourself:

Note poor quality printing on invoice is how it appeared in the email.

Take a careful look at the email address for the email sender. The address was: norton@yourworld.in which does not seem legitimate.

Look up contact information online, the contact number for Norton is 844-488-4540 which does NOT match the number listed above.

Call the company (using the number you looked up, not the one on the email), or call someone your trust, to ask if this is legit.

The scammer's goal is to get your personal information.

If you called the number, listed in the email, they would "helpfully" ask for your credit card number so they could "stop the charges" or request from you a bank number/credit card number to "refund" your money. Thus gaining access to your personal information and most likely a financial loss for you. With a little TCL you can enjoy email while staying safe!
