

# Got SPAM?

*And we don't mean the kind in a can!*

Spam is junk mail sent digitally. The sender is trying to get you to either give personal information or to tap/click on something so they can get access to your information or computer.




Because the scammers goal is to fool you, spam often looks very legitimate. Before clicking on any link in an email, first look at the senders email address. If the email does not look official (such as the one below) it is SPAM. Delete the email.

If you are unsure if it is spam, call the company (using a phone number NOT from the email) and ask about the issue.
